## Year 4 Swimming Lessons

Dear Parents,

Beginning Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> April, as part of their Physical Education Curriculum, Year 4 will begin swimming lessons at the Royal School. The lessons are an opportunity for children whose water confidence or experience is limited, to gain experience and confidence in preparation of their residential visit to Dunfield house, during which, they will have the chance to go swimming. For those more experience swimmers, it is an opportunity to further develop their swimming skills. Lessons will take place every Tuesday afternoon 1.30pm-2.00pm with the children transported to the venue by coach.

Mr Morgan will be leading and coordinating the sessions as a qualified Swimming Instructor and will be supported by 2 additional swimming instructors from the Royal Swimming Academy. The Royal School will also be providing Lifeguards.

Children will need a swimming costume and towel in a waterproof bag and a waterproof coat. Please note that girls should wear a single piece swimsuit (no two-piece outfits) and boys should wear plain swimming shorts (that are no longer than knee length) or trunks. If your child has long hair, they will also need to bring a swimming cap as it is the Royal School's policy that all children with long hair wear them. If your child has their ears pierced, please ensure that they wear studs. Children will only be excused from swimming if we receive a letter or phone call from home.
