Dear Parents,

Bikeability Cycle Training for Year 4 and 6

Week beginning Monday 15th April, our Year 4 and Year 6 pupils will be taking part in a free Cycle Training Programme to be delivered by qualified Cycling Instructors from Wolverhampton City Council's Traffic and Road Safety Team. Year 4 will participate in a one afternoon playground-based cycling session spent working towards Bikeability Level 1 while our Year 6 children will participate in a one-day introduction to cycling on local risk assessed roads close to the school which is Level 2. The training aims to develop cycling skills and road safety awareness.

The date and times for the cycle training sessions for your child will follow in a separate letter once the children return after Easter. During the Easter break, please could you check to see if your child has a roadworthy bike (with both brakes fully functioning). Your child will also need a cycle helmet. Bikes, cycle helmets can be provided for those pupils who do not have their own if you inform your child's class teacher in advance.

If you have any concerns including having access to a bike or if your child is nervous about undertaking the course please contact Mr Beddall, Miss Campion or Mr Morgan. If your child is a non-rider, a separate 'learn to ride' course will be held as part of the training.
