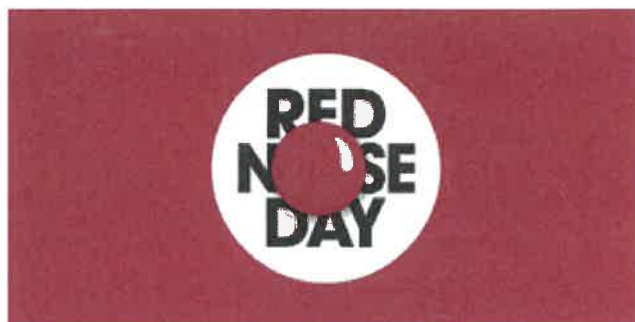

Castlecroft Primary School is committed to safeguarding its pupils and staff. To support this the school has reviewed its lockdown policy and procedures to be followed where circumstances dictate that our pupils, staff and visitors are required to remain within the school building for their own safety.

On very rare occasions it may be necessary to seal off the school so that it cannot be entered from the outside. This will ensure that pupils and adults are safe in situations where there is a hazard in the school grounds or outside the school in the near vicinity.

We will, of course, need to practice this procedure from time to time, to ensure the staff are confident in their roles and pupils are not anxious or worried. To prepare the pupils, we will discuss this in class and in assembly so that they understand what they need to do and how it will help them to stay safe.
