Word/phrase	Definition
Climate change	Increased levels of carbon dioxide affecting the planets climate
Climate	Weather conditions over a long time –a pattern of weather and temperature
citizen	An inhabitant of a town/city/state/the world
inhabitant	Someone or something that lives in or occupies a place
Plastic pollution	The harmful build up of plastic damaging the environment as it doesn't decompose
decompose	Break down and go back to nature
environment	The natural world or a particular area where people and animals live
impact	Have a strong positive or negative effect on something
bias	Prejudice against a person or group which makes you treat them unfairly or differently in a negative way
stereotype	An unfair belief about a group or type of person classing all people in a group or type as though they were the same
Pathways into work	Ways to get a job like university, training college, apprenticeships etc.
