Year 2 Residential Visit to Kingswood Nursery/Infant Centre

It gives me great pleasure to inform you that your child has the opportunity to make a residential visit to Kingswood Nursery/Infant Centre, Albrighton on Wednesday 14th May. We will leave at about 9.30am and return at 3.00pm on Thursday 15th May, travelling by coach. The visit will form part of the children's topic work for the term, but will also provide the chance for a wide variety of social and educational experiences.

Due to the current economic situation we have managed to reduce the price of the visit, with help from our school fund to cover most of the cost of the coach. The total cost for each child will therefore be £95.00 for this residential visit and needs to be paid by ParentPay. (You will be able to make a few instalments between now and then or make the whole payment of £95.00). This is for one night's stay with tea and supper on the Wednesday, and breakfast and lunch on the Thursday. A packed lunch will be needed for the Wednesday which can be provided by our school kitchens. Please complete the attached lunch order form and return it to school if you would like the kitchen to provide one or alternatively you can send your own packed lunch. No extra spending money is needed for this trip. There is also a letter with general information, and a medical/consent form which must be returned to school by Friday 11th April at the latest.

A Residential Visit to Kingswood Trust – Information for Parents/Guardians and Consent - Form 2

A visit to Kingswood Trust will provide your child with many valuable learning opportunities, enjoying a variety of practical outdoor activities with their friends and teachers. Kingswood Trust is surrounded by beautiful woodland, six miles to the west of Wolverhampton near to the village of Albrighton. Kingswood Trust is an award-winning charity that holds the "Learning Outside the Classroom Quality Badge" and has also been accredited as Covid-19 Secure. This means our centre has been inspected and has all the necessary measures and policies in place for a high quality and safe educational visit.

Before the visit, a careful plan is made following joint discussions with your child's teachers, to ensure that we provide appropriate activities so that everyone can participate fully. This may include animal handling and observing wildlife, pond dipping, mini-beast safaris, tracks and trails, adventurous games, visiting the air raid shelters and using a variety of large and small outdoor equipment. The children will experience walking in the countryside which may take them across to the Kingswood common, through local villages, through farmland, woods and fields. They will use maps, follow routes and learn about the countryside code.

The centre has four bedrooms which are warm and welcoming. We have waterproof beds, modern bedrooms and bedding. The children will arrive at Kingswood on the first morning at about 10.00am and return to school at the usual home time on the second day. All hot meals, snacks and drinks are provided (see below for packed tea information). With advance notice special diets may be arranged.

During the visit, children will be encouraged to work together, helping each other throughout the day and with bedroom jobs and bed making.

The suggested kit list for an overnight visit is as follows:

Night clothes
Toilet bag containing – toothbrush, toothpaste, flannel, soap, brush or comb and a towel.
Indoor shoes or slippers
Trainers or suitable outdoor shoes
Wellies (in a carrier bag)
Waterproof coat
Long sleeved top and T shirt
Long trousers/jog pants
Change of clothes (including underwear and extra socks for winter)
Hat, gloves and scarf (winter) Sunhat and sunscreen (summer)
Soft toy for bed
2 named plastic carrier bags
A water bottle (empty to avoid spillage on the journey here)

NB: Please ensure all belongings are clearly named.


We advise children to wear play clothes rather than best and that jewellery should be left at home. Long sleeves and long trousers will protect your children against the undergrowth in summer and provide warmth in winter. Please bring your wellies if you have them in a separate carrier bag with extra socks, hat, gloves and scarf in the colder months and a sun hat in the warmer months. Please make sure all your child's belongings are clearly named. The children enjoy working outside in all weathers and so we provide waterproof coats and trousers and wellies for loan should they be required.

The children will arrive at Kingswood in the morning about 10.00am and return to school at the usual home time.
